Even the Best Kept Lawns Need Attention!

We are in full swing of the spring season and we hope it's been a good one for you! By the time you read this, we'll be wrapping up the first round of our fertilizer and weed control applications and preparing for round two. Our fertilizer is an organic-based granular product and the weed killer is a liquid that we apply to affected areas. We recommend limiting traffic to these areas until the liquid is dry.

If your lawn is dried out, it may be due to the drought from last fall and low precipitation that took place during the winter. We've noticed bare patches in areas where lawns are well cared for—it happens to the best of us! While it may be too soon to know the extent of the damage, you can take measures that will nurture your lawn back to life. In this newsletter, we've provided some helpful tips.

Assess soil conditions. Do you need to add compost or lime?

Apply preemergent weed control in the spring.

Change oil in your lawn mower, set height to 3", sharpen blades.



6

Water during droughts—up to 1" to 1.5" of water per week.
